





The County Board of Supervisors of Kenosha County, Wisconsin does hereby ordain:

Kenosha County Ordinance, Section 7.025 on TRAFFIC CONTROLS is hereby amended by creating Section (2) (gg) as follows:

(gg) Four-Way Stop on intersection of County Trunk Highway "EA" and County Trunk Highway "A". Traffic from all directions shall stop at the intersection of C.T.H. "EA" and C.T.H. "A", and a Stop sign shall be placed at each corner of the intersection. This intersection is located in said Kenosha County, Wisconsin in the Village of Somers.

We will be seeking damages from the County for my vehicle, medical bills, towing charges (as my vehicle had to be towed from the scene and all the way to my home in DeKwan, Wisconsin. A replacement watch, & the appropriate remuneration needed to compensate for this horrific experience.
